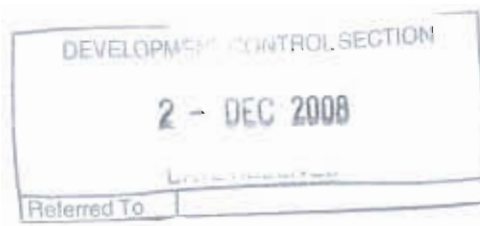

Comments:

I write with my objection to the above planning application and to express my concerns.

- 1) Car parking - concerns that parking space on site is inadequate and should not lead to overspill parking on land to the east of Bardney Hall. We note the reference in the "Proposed Use", paragraph 4: to overspill being accommodated in public parking areas on Whitecross Street, however feel constraints should be placed on the applicant not to utilise the green area to the east of Bardney Hall, that is not part of the property subject to the application, as auxiliary car parking, as this causes a nuisance to neighbouring properties.

Also would this green area, in that event, not require a separate planning application for use for temporary vehicle storage?

- 2) Proceedings that will continue late into the night – concerns that controls should be placed on the extent of receptions, entertaining and noise levels, such that it does not cause nuisance to neighbouring properties.

- 3) Light pollution – concerns that controls should be placed on the siting and direction of mobile & static event lighting, such that it does not cause nuisance to neighbouring properties.
- 4) Frequency of events – concerns that controls should be placed on the number and nature of events, with a maximum of one event in any calendar month, so that it does not cause undue nuisance to neighbouring residential properties.
