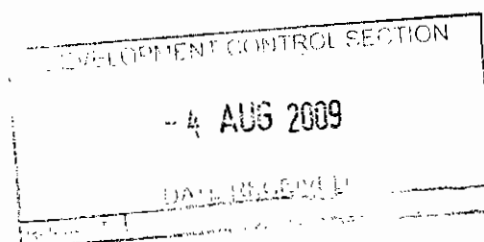

You must make your appeal within six months from that date.
