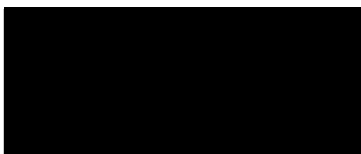

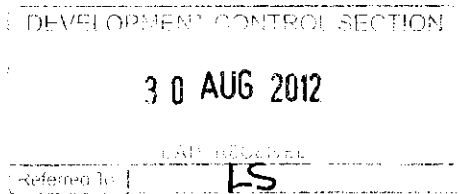

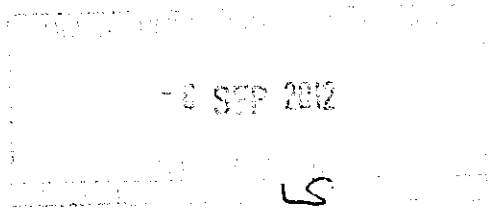

I am writing to express my concern about the proposed raised roof height of the 12 car garage at no. 56 St. Barnabas Rd.

This is already an extremely large, almost industrial sized garage for a residential area. It was previously a funeral car and taxi business.

The proposed plans for the extension roof show internal supports which would indicate that this would accommodate a large room. This supports the fears of other residents that this garage may eventually be turned into a dwelling.

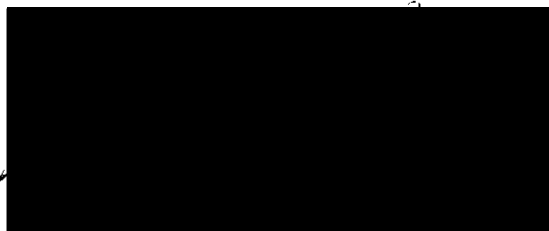
The increased height of the roof will make the building even more imposing when viewed from our garden and conservatory.

The 3 large windows in the new roof, which would be more steeply angled, would face directly onto our garden and conservatory, thereby decreasing our privacy. With the windows open the noise, particularly of the drum practice would be even more of a nuisance.

I hope you will bear this in mind when deciding the planning permission.

My neighbour (58 St Barnabas Road) told me that there was a planning application to raise the roof on a garage at the above address. My husband and i had not been notified in the post which i found odd since it would affect our property. Maybe the letter got lost in the post?

I would like to object to the planning permission for the following reasons

- View: Raising the roof would mean that the view of the hills and woodland behind the garage would be blocked from our home even more
- Eye sore: The building is a very large industrial looking one and would look more out of place and an eye sore if it got even larger. Barnetby is a lovely rural village; this would look so out of place and industrial. It already dominates the place it is situated
- Privacy: The new added window would look directly into our rear bedroom and bathroom windows. This is a privacy issue. We bought a house with no houses behind it and long back garden so we wouldn't have people looking over us
- Light: The building already blocks all the sun from our neighbour's garden. I think raising the height would mean it would block some of our natural light too
- Noise pollution: The building is already used to hold motor cycles and a drum kit. The owner spends hours revving the bike engines, playing loud music and banging on the drum kit which is a real noise problem for us and the surrounding homes. Is making it bigger to store more noise polluting items? (it can already hold approx 16 cars, why would he need more space)
