- Proposed location of new 6m galvanised tubular steel column to be fitted with Holophane VMX.L024.V1.F4L2 2.2 Klm LED lantern incorporating a SELC One Part Photocell, switching Regime 35/18 Lux. Lantern to be mounted post top at zero degrees tilt.
- ⊕ Proposed location of new 5m galvanised octagonal steel mid hinged column to be fitted with Holophane VMX.L024.V1.F4L2 2.2 Kl m LED lantern incorporating a SELC One Part Photocell, switching Regime 35/18 Lux. Lantern to be mounted post top at zero degrees tilt.
- Location of existing lighting columns to be remain.

Notes

1. The drawing does not detail statutory undertakers information. This should be sourced by the Contractor prior to the commencement of works.
 2. Road lighting columns shall be sited in rear of footway or grass verge (where applicable) Road lighting columns where situated in grass verge/Service strip shall have a set back of 0.8m (Front face of kerb to front face of column).
 3. All new columns to be connected to Northern Powergrid Underground mains network.
