I have a photograph of the Duke William Pub, back in the 80's when the pub had a roof space window wood construction, in the right hand side gable end above 25 Church Street, which was smaller than the one that is in place now which is PVC. The glazing is also clear.

This overlooks onto my roof veluxes- bedroom and bathroom, and i have had to use opaque window plastic to keep my privacy.

I wish to request if any decision is passed at this meeting, that the window to be re instated as like for like of the older one, which is more in keeping from the historical picture. Also to be of obscured glazing.
