Regarding the proposed lorry park on Falklands way:

If permission is granted, I feel it is very important that the landscaping is given high priority. The land on which it is planned to site the lorry park had been "wild" for a considerable time. A wide variety of native hedging, trees and banking towards the main road side for wildflowers would to some extent offset the very industrial nature of the development. "Supermarket" shrubby landscaping is largely useless to wildlife. Rubbish disposal facilities should also be considered. Parked lorries near the Pasture Road South/electricity station seem to generate very large amounts of litter.
