ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 THE M180 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1 TO JUNCTION 2) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited intends to make an Order on the M180 Motorway, in the County of North Lincolnshire, to enable electrical inspections and maintenance, drainage inspections and maintenance, road markings, barrier inspections and maintenance, structure inspections and maintenance, carriageway sweeping, sign cleaning and carriageway defect repair works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to start on Wednesday 6 April 2022 for 3 nights, or until completed, and will take place between 8pm and 5am.

The effect of the Order will be to close, at times during the works, the M180 Motorway:

- (i) eastbound carriageway from the exit slip road at Junction 1 (Tudworth) to the entry slip road at Junction 2 (Woodhouse), a distance of 11300 metres;
- (ii) westbound carriageway from the exit slip road at Junction 2 to the entry slip road at Junction 1, a distance of 11300 metres; and
- (iii) eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 2.

During the closures suitably signed alternative routes will be available at all times.

Traffic signs will indicate the extent of the prohibitions (which will not apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes). The Order comes into force on 5 April 2022 and has a maximum duration of eighteen months.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 THE M180 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 5) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited intends to make an Order on the M180 Motorway, in the County of Lincolnshire, to enable resurfacing works to be carried out in safety.
