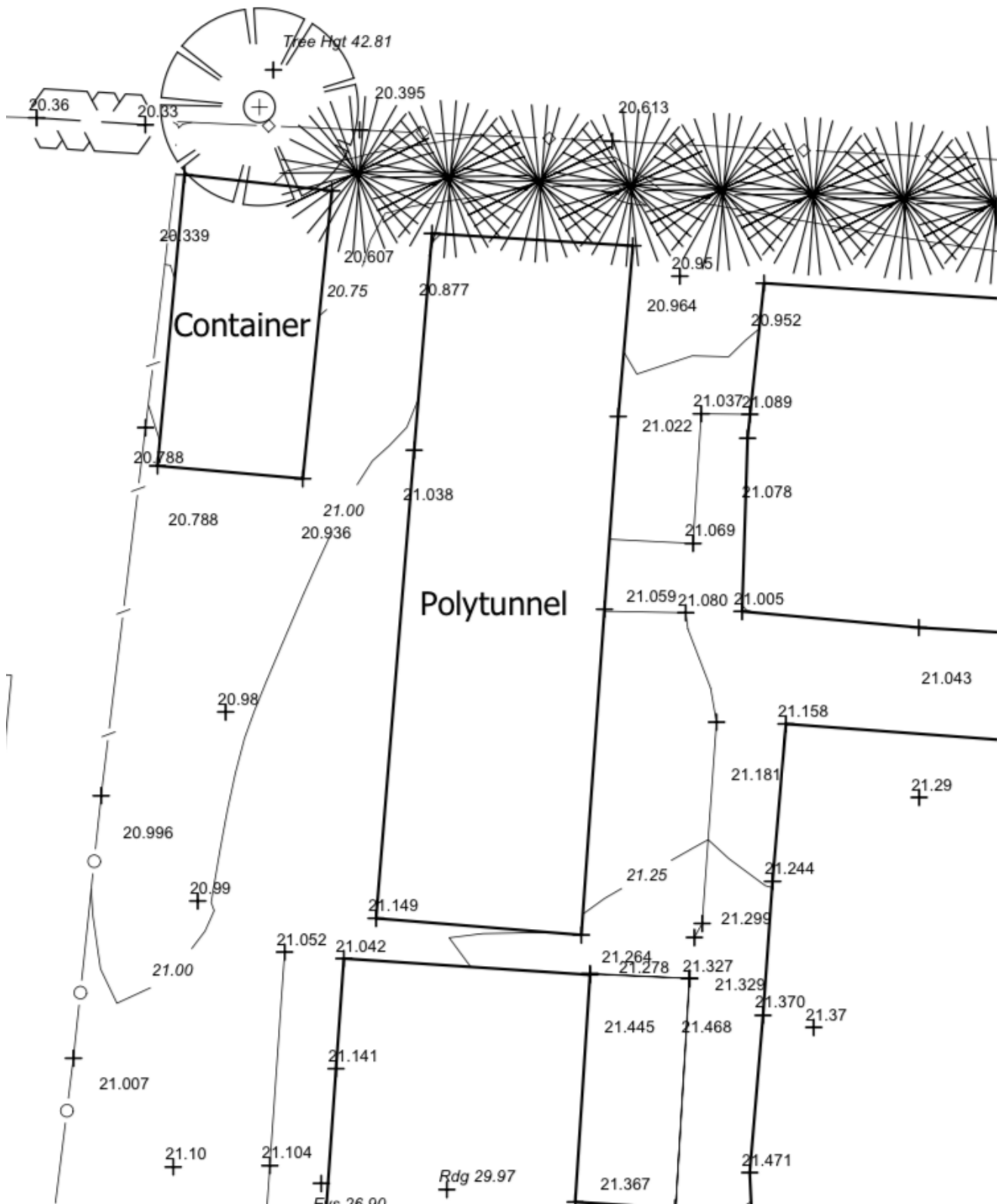

Regards this application I have concerns about a large Poplar tree that is situated on our boundary that we own adjoining this site. I have noticed on the original application this tree is included but on the revised drawings it has been omitted. Also the height of the tree on the original application is stated at 16 meters which I doubt is the full height of the tree as it presently stands. On the assumption of 16 meters an exclusion zone has been shown of 8 meters for construction but until early 2021 when we started to build our present home and lopped a large amount of the tree it actually stood at a very imposing 42 meters high this can be confirmed by the site drawings for PA/2018/569 also see attached photo. So surely the root system will be much larger than 8 meters, but there is no mention of this in the tree report. What concerns me even more is that when the contractors carried out the archeological report on this land on behalf of the applicant they started to dig a trench near this tree and pulled out some of the root structure, when I became aware of this happening I immediately stopped them going any further as they were obviously doing this without any apparent regard to health and safety or consideration for the tree. Please find attached photos and video of this incident where you can clearly see damage to the roots etc. obviously I would like a full report being carried out for this before this application is determined.
