Proposed Development Planning permission for the construction & operation of a post-combustion carbon capture plant, including carbon dioxide compressor & metering, cooling equipment, stacks, substations, internal roads, partial ditch realignment, new & modified services, connections, internal roads, accesses, maintenance & laydown areas

I refer to the above application which is within the North East Lindsey Drainage Board area. The site location includes the Board maintained South Killingholme Drain Branch 1 (A).

Under the terms of the Board's Byelaws, the prior written consent of the Board is required for any proposed temporary or permanent works or structures in, under, over or within the byelaw 9m distance of the top of the bank of a Board maintained watercourse. The applicant is aware of this and has been in discussion with the Board. It is noted that the Board maintained South Killingholme Drain Branch 1 (A) is proposed to be diverted as part of the development, the final details of this is subject consent from the Board.

Under the terms of the Land Drainage Act. 1991 the prior written consent of the Board is required for any proposed temporary or permanent works or structures within any watercourse including infilling or a diversion.

The Board has no objection to the proposed development provided it is constructed in accordance with the submitted details and Flood Risk Assessment. However should anything change in relation to the method of surface water disposal and/or in relation to the flood risk assessment etc then this Board would wish to be re-consulted. It is noted;-

- Part of the site is in Zone 2/3 on the Environment Agency Flood Maps and at flood risk. It is noted the Flood Risk Assessment is included in the Application that contains appropriate mitigation.
- Surface water discharge is attenuated to an appropriate rate or used for onsite processing.
