Please see below my response to Sports England's objection to the Parish Councils planning application to install a container on the playing field

I have detailed in the attached map the section surrounded by white is only used by the Rugby Club and on this patch on ground the Rugby club have their own container which is where their equipment is stored.

The section surrounded by red for the past 14 months has been used only by the local football group which provides football facilities for all ages under 16 for children in and around all the villages and local town of Barton Upon Humber.

The container has been requested by the football team so they have a place to store their equipment, hence the location is on the area the football team use

Historically, the Rugby club use to train on the middle field (surrounded by red), however this has not been the case for approx. 2 years and is now maintained and used by Football.

Just to confirm the unused rugby goal posts located in the red section of the playing field are in the process of being removed

I hope this response satisfies sports England's concerns and hope they understand the container is to assist in the supporting of Football to the recreational facility and does not interfere with any other sports played on the field

Dear Miss Vicky Haines,

I refer to our telephone conversation this morning regarding the objection from Sports England on the application. The main concern of Sports England is that the proposed location of the container appears to affect an existing senior rugby union pitch and therefore, affects the playing field's quantity or quality of playing pitches or otherwise adversely affects their use. Accordingly, Sports England believes it does not accord with any of the exceptions to the Playing Fields Policy or paragraph 103 of the NPPF.

Please see attached a copy of the comments from Sports England. You will also find it on the website. Please provide a response to the comments from Sports England or change the

position of the container and amend the drawing. We have to agree on an extension of time to re-consult Sports England to allow them to remove the objection.

I will recommend an extension of time until 31 January 2025. Please confirm in writing if the extension is acceptable.
