

Heritage Statement

Description

6 Low Street Winterton lies within the conservation area in Winterton. Many of the surrounding buildings are stone or brick and date from the 1700s through Victorian to more modern 20th century buildings. It's a nice mix and reflects how Winterton has had to grow and adapt over the centuries.

6 Low Street was identified as a building of neutral effect on the Townscape analysis map of Winterton.

Description of Proposed Development

6 Low Street's original wooden front door was replaced by previous property owners sometime before 2013. This door's seals have failed, and water ingress happens during heavy rain. We're aiming to replace it with a UPVC composite door which is more traditional in style and colour than the one it will replace and made of more durable materials which when maintained should last for at least the next 20 years.

The proposed works will not have a significant effect on the buildings appearance and will remain in keeping with other properties in the area.
