The colour wasn't the issue, it is the material. Anything other than a timber door would be against the authorities adopted SPG and the duty to preserve or enhance.

The wood effect, grained composite doors it isn't the wood grain that makes them inappropriate alone, it is the innate design, they cannot or do not correctly replicate traditional details, panels, mouldings etc often lacking the finesse and almost always done in awful proportions. The result is they just look like poor quality replicas, see attached example in Barton upon Humber. In the photo, the green door is a composite panelled door, unauthorised works to listed building, they applied retrospectively to sort which was given consent and hasn't been changed so will be being kicked over to enforcement.

I'd still object, if you think otherwise it'd be better to approve the original one in black rather than a white, cream one etc.
