Good morning,

Thank you for consulting with Highways on the above Screening Opinion.

Limited information has been provided within the Screening Opinion to determine whether an EIA would be warranted on Traffic and Transport Grounds. However, having looked at the Scoping Opinion (PA/SCO/2026/254), this suggests that the average daily HGV movements would be 60 - 80 per day, however it is unclear whether this is actual vehicles or two-way movements.

Given the location of the proposed development and the likely routes to/from the site, I would envisage that the proposal is unlikely to warrant an EIA on Traffic and Transport Grounds. However, any planning application will need to be accompanied by a Transport Assessment, which includes an Operational Traffic Management Plan.
