


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Brigg Ridge Children's Centre Profile 2023

Part of the North Lincolnshire JSNA

This profile provides a brief picture of public health outcomes for mothers and under 5s in the Brigg Ridge Children's Centre catchment area for 2023. This information, combined with service reach and activity data, should help agencies understand what factors are driving health improvement in this local population and enable the allocation and prioritisation of resources effectively. The profile contains information on the child population residing in its catchment area, wider determinants of health and indicators of maternal and child health.



- Brigg Ridge Children's Centre is located in Brigg and District locality and the catchment area is coterminous with Ridge ward.
- An estimated 535 under 5s live in this catchment area which represents 6% of all under 5s in North Lincolnshire; just over a quarter (27%) of resident women are of child bearing age which is the lowest in North Lincolnshire.
- The adult population of this area enjoy better than average health with male life expectancy joint highest in North Lincolnshire along with Bottesford and significantly above local and national average figures.
- This area has lower than average levels of child poverty with no neighbourhoods falling within England's 30% most deprived; just one in ten under 16s live in relative low income and one in eight are eligible for free school meals, which are both the lowest in North Lincolnshire.
- The general fertility rate in the area is average and births to women with a minority ethnic background and births to women born outside of the UK are both very low.

- The proportion of births that are premature, of low birth weight, to women under 20 and to smokers are all below average and amongst the lowest in North Lincolnshire; with nearly three quarters of women taking up breastfeeding this is significantly above average.
- Both the rate of children achieving a good level of development in the 2 ½ year check and the percentage of children ready for school at age 5 are amongst of the highest in North Lincolnshire; there are very low numbers of children in need.
- Under a fifth of 5 year olds and over a third of 11 year olds carry excess weight which is statistically similar to the North Lincolnshire average
- Accident and Emergency attendances amongst under 5s and child admissions for injuries are the lowest in North Lincolnshire.





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
