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Frodingham Children's Centre Profile 2023

Part of the North Lincolnshire JSNA

This profile provides a brief picture of public health outcomes for mothers and under 5s in the Frodingham Children's Centre catchment area for 2023. This information, combined with service reach and activity data, should help agencies understand what factors are driving health improvement in this local population and enable the allocation and prioritisation of resources effectively. The profile contains information on the child population residing in its catchment area, wider determinants of health and indicators of maternal and child health.



- Frodingham Children's Centre is located in Scunthorpe South locality with the catchment including parts of Frodingham and Kingsway with Lincoln Gardens wards.
- An estimated 295 under 5s live in this catchment area which represents just over 3% of all under 5s in North Lincolnshire making it the smallest catchment population in North Lincolnshire; two fifths of resident women are of child bearing age.
- In the adult population, male and female life expectancy is broadly in line with the local average.
- This area has statistically higher than average levels of child poverty with half of under 5s living in England's 30% most deprived neighbourhoods, a third of under 16s living relative low income and rising, a third eligible for free school meals and one in seven households with children claiming Universal Credit; claims for DLA are the highest in North Lincolnshire.
- Over a quarter of births are to women with a minority ethnic background along with nearly a fifth to mothers born outside of the UK.

- Readiness for school at 5 years and GSCE achievement in English and Maths are amongst the lowest in North Lincolnshire.
- The proportion of low weight births and births to women under 20 are some of the highest in North Lincolnshire whilst the proportion of premature births is amongst the lowest; nearly a quarter of women in the area smoke during pregnancy and three out of five women initiate breastfeeding after giving birth.
- Well over a quarter of children in the area aged 5 years carry excess weight, the highest in North Lincolnshire along with around a third of 11 year olds; neither are statistically different to local and national average figures.
- Attendances to Accident and Emergency amongst under fives are well above average and the highest in North Lincolnshire whilst admissions for injury are average and respiratory infections are very low.



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
