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


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Henderson Children's Centre Profile 2023

Part of the North Lincolnshire JSNA

This profile provides a brief picture of public health outcomes for mothers and under 5s in the Henderson Children's Centre catchment area for 2023. This information, combined with service reach and activity data, should help agencies understand what factors are driving health improvement in this local population and enable the allocation and prioritisation of resources effectively. The profile contains information on the child population residing in its catchment area, wider determinants of health and indicators of maternal and child health.



- Henderson Children's Centre is located in Scunthorpe North locality with the catchment including parts of Burringham and Gunness, Burton Upon Stather and Winterton, Crosby and Park and Town wards.
- And estimated 785 under 5s live in this catchment area which represents 9% of all under 5s in North Lincolnshire; a third (35%) of resident women are of child bearing age which is significantly above average.
- The adult population generally have lower than average health outcomes with one of the lowest female life expectancies in North Lincolnshire and male life expectancy significantly lower than the national average.
- This area has generally higher than average levels of child poverty; two fifths of under 5s reside in England's 30% most deprived neighbourhoods, over a quarter (27%) of children live in relative low income, one in ten households with children claim Universal Credit and a fifth are eligible for free school meals.

- The general fertility rate in the area is one of the lowest in North Lincolnshire; over 40% of births in the area are to mothers born outside of the UK or of a minority ethnic background.
- The rate of women booking with a BMI over 30 is second lowest in North Lincolnshire whilst low weight births are amongst the highest; over two thirds of women initiate breastfeeding after giving birth which is similar to local and national rates.
- The percentage of children achieving a good level of development in the 2½ year check is significantly better than England, however school readiness and GCSE attainment are average.
- Over a quarter (27%) of 5 year olds and a third (37%) of 11 year olds carry excess weight.
- Accident and Emergency attendances and hospital admissions are broadly in line with local average values.
