
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North Axholme Children's Centre Profile 2023

Part of the North Lincolnshire JSNA

This profile provides a brief picture of public health outcomes for mothers and under 5s in the North Axholme Children's Centre catchment area for 2023. This information, combined with service reach and activity data, should help agencies understand what factors are driving health improvement in this local population and enable the allocation and prioritisation of resources effectively. The profile contains information on the child population residing in its catchment area, wider determinants of health and indicators of maternal and child health.



- North Axholme Children's Centre is located in Crowle in the Isle locality within the ward of Axholme North and part of Axholme Central north of the M180.
- An estimated 395 under 5s live in this catchment area which represents 4.5% of all under 5s in North Lincolnshire; nearly a third (31%) of resident women are of child bearing age; and women born outside of the UK are very low in number.
- Health outcomes and life expectancy for adult residents of the area are close to average.
- Child poverty in the area is low, with under a quarter (23%) of under 5s living in England's 30% most deprived neighbourhoods; one in five under 16s live in relative low income, nearly a quarter are eligible for free school meals and a low number of households with children claim Universal Credit; the proportion of children claiming disability allowance is above average for North Lincolnshire.
- Whilst the general fertility rate and breastfeeding initiation are close to average, births to women of a

- minority ethnic background, smoking at delivery, births to women under 20 and low weight births are relatively low in number.
- Readiness for school at 5 years of age is average but GCSE attainment in English and Maths is amongst the lowest in North Lincolnshire; the proportion of children in need is marginally above the average for North Lincolnshire but has risen significantly since 2017.
- A quarter (24%) of 5 year old residents in this catchment area carry excess weight which is broadly average; by 11 years, whilst this proportion has risen to a third (33%), it is amongst some of the lowest values in North Lincolnshire.
- Accident and Emergency attendances for under 5s, are significantly lower than the local average; admissions for respiratory infections and injury are some of the lowest in North Lincolnshire.






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
