

Westcliff and The Riddings Children's Centre Profile 2023

Part of the North Lincolnshire JSNA

This profile provides a brief picture of public health outcomes for mothers and under 5s in the Westcliff and The Riddings Children's Centre catchment area for 2023. This information, combined with service reach and activity data, should help agencies understand what factors are driving health improvement in this local population and enable the allocation and prioritisation of resources effectively. The profile contains information on the child population residing in its catchment area, wider determinants of health and indicators of maternal and child health.



- Westcliff and The Riddings Children's Centre is located in Scunthorpe South locality with the catchment encompassing Brumby ward and Ashby Parklands.
- An estimated 865 under 5s live in this catchment area which represents 10% of all under 5s in North Lincolnshire; over a third (36%) of resident women are of child bearing age; and one in six (16%) are born outside of the UK.
- Health outcomes for adults living in this area are poor with life expectancy significantly below average and male life expectancy one of the lowest in North Lincolnshire.
- Child poverty in the area is one of the highest in North Lincolnshire, with more than 4 out of 5 (85%) resident children living in England's 30% most deprived neighbourhoods; nearly a third of under 16s live in relative low income (31%) or are eligible for free school meals (35%), one in six (16%) households with children claim Universal Credit and DLA claims are high; all are significantly worse than average.

- The general fertility rate is the highest in North Lincolnshire along with bookings for overweight women, births to under 20s and smoking in pregnancy; premature and low weight births are also amongst the highest in North Lincolnshire.
- At 55%, the breastfeeding initiation rate is the worst in North Lincolnshire and a quarter less than the highest rate; this is significantly worse than average.
- Whilst early years development and school readiness are in line with the local average, GCSE attainment in English and maths is amongst the lowest in North Lincolnshire.
- Well over a quarter (29%) of 5 year olds carry excess weight rising to nearly two out of five (38%) amongst 11 year olds which are both some of the highest values in North Lincolnshire.
- Accident and Emergency attendances and hospital admissions are high with admissions for respiratory infections the largest in North Lincolnshire.







