

**Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004
Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and Town and Country Planning (Local
Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008
North Lincolnshire Local Development Framework – Core Strategy Development Plan Document:
Adoption Statement – 29 June 2011**

In accordance with Regulations 24 and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (amended 2008), notice is hereby given that on 28 June 2011, North Lincolnshire Council formally resolved to adopt the North Lincolnshire Local Development Framework – Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD). The plan forms part of the Local Development Framework for North Lincolnshire. It contains strategic policies covering the period 2010-2026 and replaces relevant parts of the North Lincolnshire Local Plan (adopted May 2003). The plan area covers the entire administrative area of North Lincolnshire.

The Core Strategy DPD was considered by an independent Inspector as part of a Public Examination, with hearings held between 18 and 20 January 2011. The Inspector's report was published on 17 May 2011 and concluded that the Core Strategy DPD was 'sound', subject to a number of required changes. The adopted Core Strategy DPD incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Core Strategy DPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers of the local authorities and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the Core Strategy DPD was adopted, i.e. by **9 August 2011**.

Copies of the Core Strategy, the Inspector's Report, this Adoption Statement, the Sustainability Appraisal, the Habitats Regulation Assessment and the Environmental Statement are available for public inspection at Pittwood House, Ashby Road, Scunthorpe during normal office hours (9am - 5pm [Monday to Thursday]/9am to 4:30pm [Friday]). They are also available on the council's website at www.northlincs.gov.uk
