PLEASE READ

Anyone looking at a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) made before April 2012 needs to know that the provisions were updated to a new version which takes the place of the previous wording. Please Note the details of the making authority, the TPO reference, the First Schedule that lists the protected trees and the Map showing where the trees are located remains as per the original order.

Please see below the new wording for each TPO made before April 2012:

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

TREE PRESERVATION (name of order here) ORDER 201

THE NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order:

1 This Order may be cited as The North Lincolnshire Borough Council Tree Preservation (name of order here) Order 201.

- In this Order "the authority" means the North Lincolnshire Borough Council. In this Order, any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012.
- 3 Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners), and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall:

- (a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage or wilfully destroy; or
- (b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, uprooting, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17 or of the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23 and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.

In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.

If you are just interested to see what protection is in a certain area, or you want to read the wording of a TPO document, this can be viewed online and can also be downloaded. Viewing a copy of an order may not be enough if you need to rely on the order for legal purposes. The internet access is intended for viewing and information. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the 4 letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.


